Notes

The ANZSIL Constitution provides that at least two members of the Council (and one of the Vice Presidents) must be resident in New Zealand. No member may serve on Council for more than three consecutive terms of two years and no member may serve as President for more than two consecutive terms of two years. Allocation of Executive positions, apart from that of the office of President, shall be decided by the Council.
