### **ANZSIL Gender, Sexuality and International Law Interest Group Mentoring Program**

#### **Background:**

The ANZSIL GSIL Mentoring Program has run twice now and has been regarded as a good program by all who participated based on the feedback we received. As such we are going to run it again as per the details below.

#### **Mentoring Program:**

The GSIL Interest Group is establishing a mentoring program that will match junior academics and practitioners seeking a mentor with experienced counterparts who are willing take on that role. The formal component of this program will match mentors and mentees, who will then meet (via phone, video call, or in person as suits participants) at least once a month to discuss the career concerns and trajectory of the mentee, for a period of 12 months. At the end of 12 months both parties will provide GSIL with a short reflection on the time spent together to assist us in shaping and improving the program. It is our hope that this process will be of benefit to both parties and build relationships within our international law community that endure beyond the formal component.

Expressions of interest should provide a brief blurb of who you are, whether you want to be mentored or if you are willing to be a mentor, and what you hope to reap from the program. Participants will be matched based on these Eols.
